NOW CREATE A DOCUMENT/BROCHURE WITH ALL OF THE FACTS:

Next, describe the setting. A good description will include property dimensions, surroundings, and style (single family, detached, etc.). Use the info you wrote down above to help you.

Next paragraph, showcase the home's features. Include the specifics within the details such as room dimensions and square footage. Continue descriptions by floor. Incorporate information about utilities, school districts, taxes, and amenities.

Provide your contact information. Include your name, email, and numbers to call to set-up an appointment.
